This sends a strong message at a time when jobs and apprenticeship opportunities are becoming scarcer.

With our first two apprentices, we are taking an important step: We are training our own next generation of skilled workers and giving young people the chance to help shape the energy transition from the very beginning," said Anne Peter, HR Specialist at TRICERA.

The two apprentices are completing their training through the dual system, which follows a clearly defined training path with alternating periods of in-person instruction at the company and at vocational school.

Oskar Grau, an IT administration apprentice, said: "I'm thrilled with the work environment I've been given the opportunity to be a part of. The chance to actively contribute here from the very beginning is very important to me. After receiving such a warm welcome, I'm really looking forward to working with the team."

For his trainer Aaron Philipp, the start of the apprenticeship also marks an important milestone: "For us, a good apprenticeship is an investment in the future. We want to foster our apprentices' professional skills, provide them with practical experience, and support them in their personal and professional development."

Together with the vocational school, we will be working over the next few years to integrate Oskar and Julian as smoothly as possible into the day-to-day operations of a battery storage company and to train them to become future skilled workers in the energy sector.
